United States/Nigeria

Pray for Samuel and Rebecca Dali as they take part in several meetings with governmental and advocacy organizations regarding continued

needs in Nigeria. The Dalis served on an expert panel for Congressional staff and are participating in meetings with the Council on Foreign Relations and the State Department. Additionally, the Dalis are visiting Manchester University in Indiana, the Brethren Heritage Center in Ohio, and a few Church of the Brethren congregations.

Samuel is the former president of Ekklesiyar Yan'uwa a Nigeria (EYN, Church of the Brethren in Nigeria). Rebecca is the founder and president of Centre for Caring, Empowerment and Peace Initiatives (CCEPI) aiding victims of the Boko Haram insurgency.

Iran and Iraq

Pray for everyone affected by a powerful earthquake that struck along

the Iran-Iraq border on [Sunday](#), killing at least 530 people and injuring 7,460 more. Aid agencies report that 70,000 people are in need of shelter.
