PURPOSE

To develop and implement a music ministry that enhances the worship of God and whole ministry of the church

FAITH JOURNEY

Must be a mature believer, acknowledge Jesus Christ as his/her personal Savior and Lord, and adhere to our core values

GIFTS NEEDED

Must have the following musical skills and experience:

- Ability to read and direct music
- Ability to sing
- Proficiency in playing a keyboard
- Strong familiarity with contemporary, classical and gospel Christian music.
- Have a calling and anointing from God for ministry in music as led by the Holy Spirit

ACCOUNTABILITY

- The Music Director is accountable ultimately to Jesus, followed by the congregation, under the direction of the Executive Committee and Church Board, and under the guidance of the Senior Pastor.
- The Music Director will also interface regularly and cooperatively with other staff members, the Worship Committee, and the congregation.
- The Director of Music Ministry shall demonstrate a personal commitment to Christ.
- The Director of Music Ministry will receive a six and twelve-month evaluation the first year, and an annual evaluation thereafter.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead and accompany worship with sensitivity to the leading of the Holy Spirit
- Organize, audition, rehearse, and coordinate worship team
- Select, obtain, and maintain a library with a variety of worship music
- Select and coordinate "Special Music"
- Select and coordinate accompanists(s) and musician(s) for all services
- Oversee lyric displays for services
- Oversee Sound Team leader
- Coordinate music for special events such as Easter and Christmas
